Park “Low Risk Use” Policy

The following policy has been established to allow full use of all City Parks for all low risk events which may be enjoyed freely without making reservation. Low risk use is defined as anything other than high risk activities which have a higher potential for bodily harm or property damage (Examples of high risk: Demolition Derby, Rodeo, Fair, Truck and Tractor pulls, etc.).

When reserved or exclusive use of a pavilion, facility, table, court or other amenities in the park is desired, reservations may be made by filling out a single sheet with contact information through City Hall, and pay a fee of \$10.00 for City residents and \$15.00 for non-residents. Only Ellis O. Jackson Park (a.k.a. “Fairgrounds”) may be used for high risk events and the Public Event Policy defines the regulations and requirements for all high risk use

All persons using the City Parks are subject to the laws, ordinances, rules, policies, regulations and orders of the City of Marshfield, Missouri, State and Federal government.
